Our Programs



Les Petits

Ages 4-6: Les Petits teaches the foundations of singing in an active and engaging way. Musical play engages these young singers as they learn the foundations of theory and music. Participating in the seasonal concerts allows these young musicians to showcase their developing musicianship for an audience.

Junior Choir

Treble voices, ages 7-12: Choristers sing varied repertoire in many styles, mainly one and two part arrangements. This work develops a basic understanding of successful group singing, music theory, and score reading, unlocking the joy and social-emotional benefits of choral singing. Junior choir participates in seasonal concerts, festivals, workshops and trips throughout the season.





Senior Choir

Mixed voices, ages 12-19. The music is challenging and varied: choristers are exposed to many forms of choral music and sing in several different languages, developing awareness of global and classical music. Participants sing in up to four-part harmonies with Soprano, Alto, Tenor, and/or Bass voices, and develop a strong understanding of music theory and score reading. This group works to a very high standard of choral singing.

Musical Theatre Intensive

Our thrilling triple threat training program for youth who share a passion for the performing arts. Weekly classes, workshops and lessons in all disciplines required for the stage, screen and recording studio. The comprehensive program builds self-confidence and team-building skills, while allowing each child to find their individual voice. This year we are working towards putting on a fully staged production of Matilda Jr. at Victoria Hall in Cobourg.

Christine Rabey (she/her) is a mezzo-soprano, choral conductor, and secondary teacher who is excited to be integrating into the Northumberland community. She is a graduate of the University of Western Ontario with an Honours Bachelor of Music Education, and received her Masters of Teaching at the University of Toronto. A lifelong lover of choral music, Christine was a section lead at Metropolitan United Church in London during her undergraduate studies, and more recently sung as a section lead for the Modern Sound Collective and the choir at Royal York Road United Church. She has served as Conducting Intern with Young Voices Toronto, and as an Associate Conductor with the Oakville Choir for Children and Youth before starting with La Jeunesse, where she has so enjoyed combining her passion for choir and musical theatre!
